

Tyrone Edward Rotunno, born June 25th, 1967, is an American artist, multi-instrumentalist, songwriter, and music producer from Los Angeles, California. His latest single *Ring Out*, will be released January 2021. As a follow-up, he will be releasing an album of 8 original songs, including *Ring Out*, later in the year.

Owing to the pandemic lockdown in early 2020, Rotunno began remote collaborations with pianist/multi-instrumentalist Jaime Luis Oliveira from Lisbon, Portugal. After hearing the song *Devil Jumped High*, from Rotunno's 2011 release *Tyrone & The Golden Boys*, Oliveira reached out and contacted Rotunno. Upon hearing Olivera playing piano live on Zoom, Rotunno invited Olivera to collaborate on the single *Red Gold Evening*, which he was creating in honor of his wife's birthday. Through audio file exchanges, Zoom calls, and emails, the two conspired to create a musical expression of timeless, enduring romance. The single, featuring Olivera on piano, was released May 10th, 2019. In November of that same year, Rotunno contributed to the score and was credited as Music Supervisor for the movie "Natural Disasters" released January 2020.

Since 2015, Rotunno has concentrated on mastering recording and audio production. He has grown adept at taking an imagined idea through the journey from creative musings to a completed work. His distinctive artistry integrates literary and musical influences into enduring songs.

From 2008 to 2014 Rotunno self-released 2 studio EP's, composed music for the movie soundtrack SEDONA, performed live in a music ensemble, founded and led the band Tyrone & The Golden Boys, while playing drums and percussion for the L.A. band Shots In The Dark.
